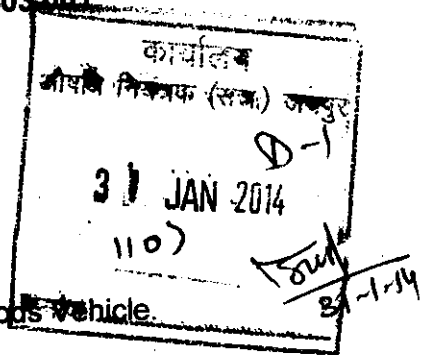

Sub: Information related to the Dacoity & Looting of our Goods Vehicle

16/1/14

This is in reference to your telephonic enquiry on 15th January 2014 evening requiring information related to the dacoity & Looting of our Goods Vehicle.

Please note that our Goods vehicle (MH.04.EY.3765) of Ms. Senior Translines which left our premises to transfer goods to our Central Hub in Bhiwandi late evening on 13th January 2014 was waylaid by dacoits in a truck near Sawantwadi in the midnight, the driver was beaten badly, tied to a pole & goods robbed.

Our Warehouse Executive Mr. Jeetesh Prabhu visited yesterday late evening at the Sawantwadi Police station & also the FDA office at Oros, Sindhudurg District and met Mr. Shashikant Yadav. The Vehicle has been now released after recording the FIR by the driver, statement by the company representative Mr. Jeetesh Prabhu and receipt of release and possession of the vehicle (Photocopies of all 3 documents enclosed) and is proceeding towards our Central Hub at Bhiwandi with remaining goods.
