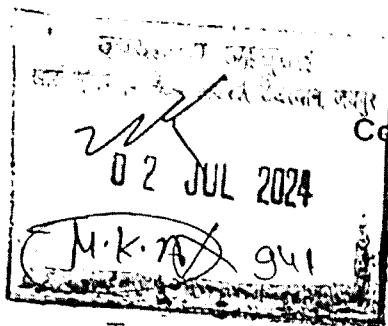

With reference to the complaint letter cited above received by this office, wherein, the complainant stated that Blood Centres from States of Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Haryana and Punjab are transferring Blood units to the Blood Centres of UP and Bihar in thermocol boxes with ice packs using private transport without maintaining the temperature and further selling the units in higher rates than prices fixed by Government. (A copy of the complaint is attached herewith)

Therefore, you are directed to investigate the matter along with the officials from concerned CDSCO office and initiate necessary action as deemed fit under the provisions of Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 & Rules, 1945. Further, instruct your inspectorate staff to keep a vigil on such type of activities.

Respected Sir,

With all due respects, I Dr. Vivek Singh Chakravarti, Medical Officer, In Charge , Achintya Blood centre, Etawah, UP hereby informing you that Blood centres from Maharashtra , Rajasthan, Haryana & Punjab are transferring blood units to the blood centres of UP & Bihar without maintain the temperature and time fixed for such transfer.

Sir, these blood centres transfers blood units in thermocol boxes with ice packs which not have a constant temperature, their for PRBC (Packed Red Blood Cells) are hemolysed or damage.

When the such PRBC are transfused to the Patients, this increase sudden renal load resulting in High Blood urea and creatinine level in the recipients. In healthy recipients, this renal load will normalize in 24 to 48 Hrs, but the recipients with already compromised renal status such as the pregnant females, patients with renal diseases suffers with acute renal failure which may lead to the death of such recipients.

As the death of the recipients are due to Acute Renal Failure, they are not reported for hemo vigilance purpose.

The blood centers who received the bulk transfer sell these products in excessive rates from the prize fixed by the government, which affect the wealth of the Patients.

Usually such types of the bulk transfer are not reported to the State Blood Transfusion Councils of their Respected States and to the National Blood Transfusion Council, the earning and profit from such trading converted into the Black money.

At present, this types of transportation has been done by the private transporter, who involves in various types of illegal activities, there for it is mandatory to track these transporters and vehicles not only for the purpose of the temperature maintenance but for the National Security purpose.

As the State Blood Transfusion Council, is the implementing and monitoring body for the day to day procedures of blood banking, I request to you for declare a Standard Operating Procedure for maintain, monitor and control such types of Illegal Transportation and also to Inquire the matter by law enforcement Agencies so that the lives and wealth of the people at large could be saved.

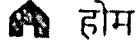

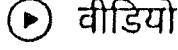

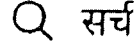
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राजस्थान और यूपी में खून का अवैध रिश्ता सामने आया है। 'खून की तस्करी' करने वाले गिरोह के सक्रिय सदस्य लगातार अपना साम्राज्य फैला रहे हैं और ड्रग विभाग आंखें मूंदे है। पिछले दिनों उत्तर प्रदेश के लखनऊ में पकड़े गए खून के सौदागर डॉ. अभय ने कबूल किया था कि वह जयपुर से रक्तदान शिविर लगाकर यूपी-बिहार में खून का बेचान करता था।

भास्कर ने मामले की तह तक पड़ताल की तो चौंकाने वाला खुलासा हुआ। मामले के अनुसार, झुंझुनूं से आ रही ब्लड वैन को 16 मई को जयपुर की चित्रकूट पुलिस ने नाके पर रोका। पुलिस ने वैन चालक से ब्लड सम्बन्धी जानकारियां मांगी। सही जवाब नहीं मिलने पर पुलिस ने ड्रग विभाग को सूचना दी।

सूत्रों की मानें तो मौके पर पहुंची डीसीओ सीमा तनान ने बेचान का बिल और अन्य ब्लड संबंधी कागजात नहीं होने के बावजूद वैन को जाने दिया। हालांकि झुंझुनूं के सहायक औषधि नियंत्रक (एडीसी) देवेन्द्र गर्ग ने ब्लड डोनेशन कैंप और 100 यूनिट ब्लड बिना कागजात के झुंझुनूं से फिरोजाबाद भेजना पाया गया। इस संबंध में झुंझुनूं के श्री आरएलजेटी ब्लड बैंक को दोषी पाया गया। बकौल गर्ग, रिपोर्ट ड्रग कंट्रोलर को सौंप दी है।

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1. जांच रिपोर्ट के पॉइंट नं. 10 में साफ लिखा है- झुंझुनूं के ब्लड बैंक श्री आरएलजेटी ने 100 यूनिट ब्लड अवैध रूप से बेचा। विस्तृत रिपोर्ट में मास्टर रिकॉर्ड में करीब 150 यूनिट ब्लड का रिकॉर्ड नहीं मिलना पाया गया।

2. पहले पॉइंट में ही बताया है कि ब्लड बैंक ने मूल लाइसेंस ही प्रस्तुत नहीं किया। 3. ब्लड बैंक ने कैंप की सूचना किसी भी स्तर पर नहीं दी थी यानी ब्लड बैंक द्वारा लगाए गए कई कैंप फर्जी हैं। 4. तीसरे पॉइंट में है- ब्लड बैंक के लिए अनुमोदित मेडिकल ऑफिसर व तकनीकी स्टाफ की अनुपस्थिति में ब्लड कलेक्शन किया गया। डोनर फॉर्म भी अधूरे भरे थे। निजी वैन का इस्तेमाल किया गया।

5. ब्लड को फिरोजाबाद के लक्ष्मी चैरिटेबल ब्लड बैंक को बिना लिखित आदेश व बिना बिल बेचने के लिए ले जाया जा रहा था। 6. मौके पर सीपीडी ब्लड बैंक का एलिजा किट, एमपी टेस्ट किट, बीडीआरएल किट का कोई रिकॉर्ड नहीं मिला।
