The Expert is required to have a good working knowledge of specialized software and other system requirements for the secure storage and comparison of DNA profiles.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

The Project entails the setting up of a Forensic DNA Databank for the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago. The Deoxyribonucleic Acid (DNA) Act 2007, the national DNA legislation for the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago was assented to on September 28, 2007. The Act requires that testers (i.e. DNA Analysts) submit DNA profiles to the Forensic DNA Databank within seven (7) working days of preparing a forensic report. It also provides for a Custodian of the Forensic DNA Databank with responsibility for the receipt and storage of all DNA profiles, as well as carrying out of searches against the Forensic DNA Databank. A copy of the Act is attached for your information.

To date, a total of approximately one thousand (1,000) DNA profiles of suspects, crime scenes and volunteers have been generated by forensic DNA laboratories from samples submitted by local Law Enforcement. However, in the absence of a Custodian and a Forensic DNA Databank, searches cannot be carried out between the profiles generated from different cases. Additionally, the Forensic DNA Databank would facilitate the storage of DNA profiles from the criminal population and also speculative searches using these profiles.


The absence of a Forensic DNA Databank is severely affecting the investigative efforts of the national Law Enforcement agencies. Between the period 2004 to 2008 there has been a one hundred and ten percent increase in homicide cases in Trinidad and Tobago. In keeping with its vision to obtain developed nation status by the year 2020 and ensure that Trinidad and Tobago will be a safe and secure place to live, visit, do business and raise families, the Government is committed to the use of all available modern technology to detect, solve and reduce crime.

The expert will be required to establish the Forensic DNA Databank. Consequently, he/she is initially expected to liaise with key stake holders and provide information as to the necessary equipment, personnel and protocols for the establishment of the Databank. Thereafter he/she will be required to manage the setting up and maintain the Forensic DNA Databank with the support staff provided.




