In pursuance of the provisions of clause (p) of section 2 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995, (Central Act No. 1 of 1996), the State Government hereby specifies, for the purpose of issue of certificate of disability as mentioned in clause (t) of the said section 2, the hospitals and institutions mentioned in column 3 of the table given below, as "Medical Authority" for the type of disability mentioned in column 2 thereof, and further directs that the Medical Officer of the hospital/institution as mentioned in column 4 shall be authorized to sign the disability certificate on behalf of the Medical Authority, namely:-

Note:

- (i) In respect of categories mentioned at serial number 1,2 and 3 of the table above, if in a Hospital, mentioned in column 3, a doctor with a Post Graduate degree in the relevant discipline is not available, the Head of such Hospital may utilize the services, in accordance with such guidelines as may be issued by the State Government in this respect, of a retired Government specialist or other private specialist practicing at that place or elsewhere in the district or a specialist from a nearby medical college and having requisite qualifications. However, in case of services taken from a non-government specialist, the certificate will be valid only when countersigned by the Principal Medical Officer in case of District Hospitals or head of other hospitals mentioned in column 2 of the table above against item 2 and 3.
- (ii) Likewise, if a Hospital mentioned above does not have requisite assessment facilities, the Head of such Hospital may use the facilities of a non-Government Laboratory/testing facility located at the same place or at a nearby place in the District in accordance with such guidelines as the State Government may lay down.

Explanation:

- (i) "Primary Health Centre" means Medical facility in rural area covering a population of 20-30 thousand providing preventive services and primary curative services headed by Medical Officer.
- (ii) "Community Health Centre" means Medical facility covering a population of up to 1 lac. providing preventive treatment facilities (specialty services) in Medicine, Surgery and Gynaecology and Pediatrics as labeled as first Referral Unit.

- (iii) "Civil Dispensaries" means outpatient services in urban areas managed by Medical Officer.
- (iv) "District Hospital" means institution at District level providing secondary curative care headed by Principal Medical Officer (PMO).
- (v) "Statutory local body" means:-
 - (a) A Panchayat as defined in clause (d) of Article 243 of the Constitution of India;
 - (b) A Municipality as defined in clause (e) of Article 243 P of the Constitution of India; and
 - (c) Any other local body established by or under a law passed by the legislature of the State.
