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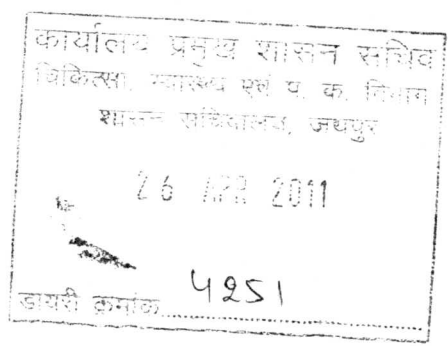

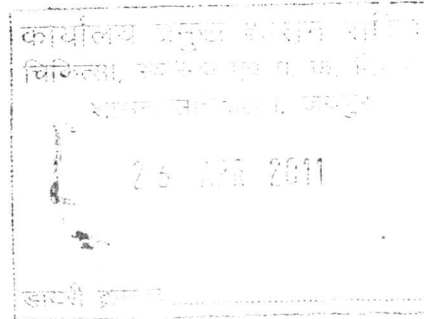

PHFI, in an effort to address this gap, has been offering a unique 9-month semi-residential PG diploma course in health economics designed mainly for mid-career professionals in government and related non-government fields since 2008-09. The overall goal of this course is to increase awareness and appreciation of the need for incorporating an economics perspective to various public health issues. It will provide a basic understanding of key issues in health economics and economic evaluation for informed decision-making and policymaking (including health care financing, pharmaco-economics, etc.).
