In India, nearly 200 persons per million populations suffer from End Stage Kidney Failure (ESKF) every year and requires maintenance dialysis and or kidney transplant. There is acute shortage of qualified nephrologist to provide Dialysis to these patients. As a result of which large number such persons, especially in district/ sub-district hospitals/ towns, who are able to afford dialysis, but still not able to get for the want of trained physician for dialysis. Further, due to same reason, many dialysis facilities are taken care by untrained personals resulting in morbidity and mortality of these patients. Therefore, there is need of trained physician who can provide dialysis facility to such patients.

To provide facilities of dialysis by these physicians and thus training to these physicians, The Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, has signed a MoU with School of Health Sciences, Indira Gandhi National Open University, New Delhi for developing and launching a Post Doctoral Certificate programme in Dialysis Medicine of one year duration through blended learning.

IGNOU has already advertised this programme throughout the country, inviting applications from the doctors possessing MD (Medicine or Pediatrics) qualification for regular as well sponsored candidates. The details are available on the IGNOU website www.ignou.ac.in. The last date for submitting of application is 31st August, 2011. The Programme will start soon thereafter.

You are requested to sponsor eligible and interested physicians/ pediatricians to this programme, which is being offered through 15 tertiary care apex institutions/ hospitals (Programme Study Centres) throughout the country (list enclosed). This one year programme has 6 month hands-on-skill development training in these hospitals and remaining 6 months will be through Open Distance Learning. IGNOU has levied the fee of Rs. 30000/- for the entire duration of programme (to be paid to IGNOU). You are requested to give the sponsored candidates paid leave for 6 months (out of 12 months period of the programme) for the skill development training in any of the identified institution/ hospital (Programme Study Centre).

You will appreciate that the doctors so trained in dialysis medicine will be great asset to your department/ hospitals and society as a whole and will be able to set up standalone-dialysis facilities in the hospitals in your state/ organization.
