Treatment prescription: Every patient should receive a prescription of the treatment advised to him. If the procedures for dispensing involves a dispensing slip, that may also be provided to the patient.

The outpatient services should have provisions for both – the new patients as well as for the old patients on follow-up. Inpatient Treatment services:

Patients of mental disorders, who require in-patient management should be admitted in a dedicated ward which is exclusively meant for this purpose. Thus, each district hospital should have an exclusive, 10-bedded psychiatry ward. While the duration
