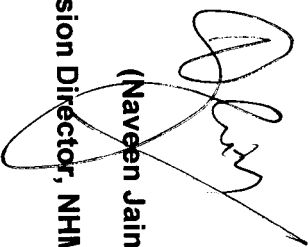
Addendum No. 2
