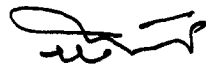

SECTION-I: INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS (ITB)

Important Instruction :- The Law relating to procurement " The Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Act, 2012 " [hereinafter called the Act] and the " Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Rules, 2013 [hereinafter called the Rules] under the said act have come into force which are available on the website of State Public Procurement Portal <http://sppp.raj.nic.in> . Therefore, the bidders are advised to acquaint themselves with the provisions of the Act and the Rules before participating in the bidding process. If there is any discrepancy between the provisions of the Act and the Rules and this bidding document, the provisions of the Act and the Rules will prevail.

Before filling up of bid form, kindly go through the following instructions carefully so that your bid may not be considered invalid:

Description

1. Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakaram (RBSK), introduction in nutshell:

National Health Mission Rajasthan has implemented the RBSK program across all the 34 districts of state of Rajasthan, by recruiting dedicated Mobile Health Teams (MHTs), at the block level and further by establishing District Early Intervention Centers (DEICs), at the district level. Under RBSK, children (new-born to 18 years of age) are being screened and identified by the MHTs with a set of pre-defined 38 conditions, broadly categorized under 4Ds (Defects at birth, Deficiencies, Diseases of childhood and Developmental delays including disability). Further, diagnosis and treatment of the identified children at secondary and tertiary level institutions.

2. List of Health conditions, Procedures and Model Costing of Surgeries under RBSK:

A surgical package includes the cost of all pre-operative investigations, cost of surgery, cost of post-operative care including hospital stay and follow up care including medicines/consumables.(Any additional stay in case of undue and unforeseen complications may be included separately provided proper justification has been made). The preauthorization of surgeries from the Govt. empanelled experts before conducting the procedure would be done on the basis of pre-operative investigations and the reimbursement of the bills to the hospital will be done after receiving the Post-operative evidence along with the other requisite documents.

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

(Please read all the terms and conditions carefully before filling the application form and the annexures)

1. Security/ Performance Guarantee Deposit:

The bidders in the technical bid would be required to deposit Bid Security/ of Rs. 300000/- (rupees three lacs only) for Surgeries through. Demand draft/Bank Gaurantee along with technical Bid submission. The scanned copies of DD and BG should be submitted electronically on e-procument and in physical form must be submitted as well

Before signing of MOU, successful bidder has to submit Performance security that is 5% of total estimated amount as intimated at the time of signing MOU. It will be in form of DD/BG in the favour of Rajasthan State Health Society Jaipur (RSHS). A duly constituted technical committee would review the successful bidder's facilities and based on the report of the committee the formal Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) would be signed between the authorized representative of the concerned hospital and the representative of National Health Mission Rajasthan. The Performance Security will be refundable only after the successful completion of agreement period. Here it would be significant to mention that in case of violation of the terms and conditions incorporated in the agreement, the hospital would be de-empanelled and the security/Performance deposit will be forfeited forth-with.

Bid Document Fee Rs. 2000/- DD in favour of Rajasthan State Health society, Jaipur for the document download & RISL Processing Fee 1000/- in favour of MD, RISL Jaipur shall be deposited by the bidder separately before the last date and time prescribed for online submission of Bid Document. Bid Document fees, Processing fees and bid security 3,00,000/- as B.G/DD (Bank Guarantee) as per Bid Document shall be deposited physically at the office of the Mission Director NHM (RBSK unit, room no 308)

2. Period of Empanelment:

The empanelment shall be initially for a period of one year and from the date of award of contract and may be extended on satisfactory performance of contract with mutual consent on the same terms and condition & as per provision of RTPP 2013 act & rules.

3. Tie-Up agreement:

The applicant, who fulfills all the criteria as laid down in the Bid Document and based on the track record of the services which will be assessed by the committee after review of the documents and data supplied by the concerned hospitals, would be invited for executing an agreement with the Mission Director, NHM Rajasthan through their authorized representative.

4. General Conditions for Empanelment:

The empanelment of the private hospitals for the select Procedures/ surgeries would be done at the State level by State Health Society Rajasthan, with the following general Terms & Conditions:

The Bid will be invited through advertisement, in leading newspapers, for the empanelment of the

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private hospitals performing the select Procedures/surgeries among the children of 0-18 years of age. The criteria of the empanelment would be as follows:

- I. The hospital must be empanelled either with the Govt. of Rajasthan or with CGHS.
- II. The hospital must be well equipped in all spheres, for delivering quality Procedures/surgeries in terms of infrastructure, human resources, equipments and also statutory and medico-legal conformation Submit report.
- III. The concerned surgeon of the hospital must be trained in the select procedure/ surgeries and also must possess a good track-record of performing the select procedure/ surgeries for at least preceding 3 years. Submit surgeon qualification/experience/No of surgery done during last one year.
- IV. The facility of pediatric ICU should be available.
- V. The hospital will issue estimated cost of surgery/treatment, in a prescribed format and in any case it should not exceed the existing RBSK package rate.
- VI. Hospital shall not charge more than RBSK package rate/rates, at any cost and no money should be charged, from the family of the patient. The package rate under RBSK is all inclusive (i.e. cost of procedure, hospitalization, medicines, implants and other consumables etc.).
- VII. Diet Charge for the patient is inclusive in the package and no extra money would be provided for that purpose.
- VIII. The hospital should have blood bank facility in Hospital premises, if the blood bank is owned by other than hospital its self then the letter of agreement with the blood bank owner will be considred.
- IX. The hospital should have in running condition from the last three years. (P&L of last three years of hospital should also be attached with this application form).
- X. Arrangement of voluntary blood donors for the blood/blood products required for surgery will be the responsibility of the child's family. However the hospital will have the moral responsibility to coordinate with the voluntary organizations in case of any emergency and if the family is not able to arrange donors in time.
- XI. The referral of the patient to the concerned centre would depend upon the state RBSK unit and the transportation charge from home to the city where hospital is situated and back forth, would be borne by the family.
- XII. Expenses on toiletries, cosmetics, telephone bills etc. would not be reimbursable and are not included in package rates.
- XIII. Increased duration of indoor treatment due to infection, or the consequences of surgical procedure or due to any improper procedure would be reimbursed only after the approval of the high level of committee designated for the specific purpose or by component authority of NHM.
- XIV. During the treatment in ICU, no separate room rent will be provided, wherever package rates are admissible.
- XV. The empanelled hospital shall honor permission letter issued by the competent authority and provide treatment/ investigation, facility prescribed in the permission letter. The hospital shall provide treatment/ investigation, on cashless basis.
- XVI. If one or more minor procedure culminate into major treatment procedures then in that eventuality, package charges would be permissible for major procedure and half for second procedure after approval of state RBSK unit.

- XVII. Any legal liability, arising out of such services, shall be the sole responsibility of the concerned hospital and shall be dealt with, by the concerned empanelled hospital. Services must be provided by the hospitals, duly in consonance with the terms and conditions of the agreement.
- XVIII. Patient will be referred with a proper referral form, signed by the competent authority (CMHO/RCHO/PMO/Specialist (pead./cardi. etc.)
- XIX. If any patient required, Pacemaker then Hospital will have to take permission from competent authority (from the state unit of RBSK) after the permission of state hospital will be able to do the procedure
- XX. During the inpatient treatment of beneficiary, the hospital will not ask the beneficiary or his attendant to provide separately the medicine / sundries/equipment or accessories from outside and will provide the treatment within the package rates.
- XXI. It shall be the duty and responsibility of the hospital at all times, to obtain, maintain and sustain the valid registration, high quality standard of its services and healthcare and further to have all the statutory/mandatory licenses, permits or approvals of the concerned authorities, as per the existing laws. The RBSK patients must be entertained without any queue/wait.
- XXII. The empanelled centre will investigate/treat the beneficiary patient only for the condition for which they are referred and for any other additional procedure planned, a separate permission would require to be taken. In case of unforeseen emergency of these patients during admission for approved purpose /procedure, necessary life saving measure to be taken and concerned authorities may be informed subsequently with justification.
- XXIII. Patients can't be denied treatment on the pretext of non-availability of beds, failing which treatment may be arranged from other hospital and extra expenditure incurred on treatment of the patient will be recovered from empanelled hospital against incoming/pending bills/ security money. Refusal either in writing or verbal communication, will form the basis of deduction.
- XXIV. After receiving the permission letter from the state unit, the hospital has to operate the child within 1 month positively and in case of critical cases, even as early as possible.
- XXV. Empanelled centre shall provide the services totally in consonance with the terms & conditions incorporated in the agreement. In case of violation of the provisions of the agreement by the empanelled centre there will be forfeiture of payment of the incoming/pending bills. For over billing and unnecessary procedures, the extra amount so charged will be deducted from the bills and the NHM reserve the exclusive right to terminate/discontinue the contract at any time of time.
- XXVI. Mission Director may, without prejudice to any other remedy and for breach of Agreement, in whole or partly, reserve the right to terminate the contract any point of time. The empanelled hospitals shall not terminate the agreement, without giving three (3) months prior notice. If they do so, in that eventuality, security money deposited by them, will be forfeited.
- XVII. The Institution shall be de-empanelled:-
(i) If the Hospital fails to provide any or all of the services for which it has been recognized within the period(s) specified in the Agreement, or within any extension period thereof, if granted by the NHM Rajasthan, pursuant to the conditions of Agreement or (ii) If the Hospital founds engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the Agreement. Or (iii) If the Hospital found to be involved in or associated with any unethical illegal or unlawful activities, than in that eventuality, the Agreement would be summarily suspended by the NHM, without issuance of any notice and subsequently the competent authority may terminate the Agreement, after issuing a show cause notice to that

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effect and after duly considering the reply, if any, received within 10 days of the receipt of the show cause notice. Terms and conditions could be modified, at sole discretion, of the competent authority in NHM Rajasthan only.

XXVIII. If any dispute or difference of any kind, what so ever arises between the NHM and the Empanelled Center pertaining to or arising out of the Agreement, it shall be referred to for arbitration, by the Mission Director NHM Rajasthan, who will render written award of his decision to the Parties in agreement. Arbitrator shall be appointed by the Mission Director NHM Rajasthan. The decision of the Arbitrator would be final and binding. The provision of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall apply to the arbitration proceedings. The venue of the arbitration proceedings shall be at office of Mission Director NHM Rajasthan. Any legal dispute to be settled in Jaipur (Rajasthan) Only.

XXIX. Hospital should be located in Rajasthan State will be submit their application.

XXX. Monthly report should be send by hospital to the state RBSK unit.

XXXI. For heart Surgeries :-

- Should have a dedicated Paediatric Cardiac Surgeon and Paediatric Cardiologist.
- Should have a full time (round the clock) Cardiologist / Cardiac Surgeon having experience in doing cardiac procedure.
- Should have a well equipped CCU paediatric.
- Cardiac OT and Cardiac CATH Lab must have instrumental and technical support for paediatric patient population.
- Must have optical Imaging systems for Paediatric patients.
- Cardiac OT should have, (i) Trained Cardiac anesthetic, (ii) proper perfusionist.
- Post Operative recovery should have i) proper instrumental backup ii) proper trained person.
- The concerned surgeon/ Paediatric cardiologist of the hospital must be trained in the select procedure/surgeries and also must process a good track- record of performing the select procedure / surgeries.

The hospital is responsible for managing the activities of its personnel and will hold itself responsible for their negligence, misconduct or deficiency in services, if any.

10. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES :-

Empanelled centre/hospital shall provide the services as specified under terms & conditions of agreement. In case of violation of the provisions of the agreement by the empanelled centre/hospital there will be deduction by way of penalty up to 10% of payment of the corresponding month. For over billing and unnecessary procedures, the extra amount so charged will be deducted from the bills and the State Health Society shall have exclusive

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right to terminate the contract at any time, and also render forfeiture of security amount.

11. PENALTY CLAUSE :-

16.1	Unless otherwise agreed between the MD NHM and the firm, payment/part payment for the Service at mentioned District HQ (RCHO) will be made on submission of bills in proper form by the firm. Payment shall be released on receipt of certificate of Service as norms. The firms shall seek time extension from the MD NHM, Jaipur before delayed dispatch of service. In case of disputed matter/item amount of 10 to 25 % will be with held and after settlement of that dispute, payment of said amount will be released.
16.2	Payment shall be made by PFMS/RTGS/account payee cheque, as the case may be. Expenses on this account, if any, shall be borne by the firm.
16.3	No advance payments towards cost of items will be made to the bidder.
16.4	All bills/invoices should be raised in triplicate and in the case of Excisable items; the bills should be drawn as per Central Excise Rules in the name of the authority concerned.
16.5	If at any time during the period of Agreement, the price of service provided is reduced or brought down by any law or Act of the Central or State Government or by the bidder himself, the bidder shall be bound to inform MD, NHM, Jaipur immediately about it. Purchasing authority shall be empowered to unilaterally effect such reduction as is necessary in rates in case the bidder fails to notify or fails to agree for such reduction of rates.

17. Bid Security:

18. Forfeiture of bid security:

19. Procuring entity's right to vary quantity:

- (i) If the MD NHM Jaipur procures less than the quantity indicated in the bidding documents the bidder shall not be entitled for any claim or compensation except otherwise provided in the conditions of Agreement.

20. Subletting of Agreement:

21. Grievance redressal during procurement process:

(iii) Filing an appeal

If any Bidder or prospective bidder is aggrieved that any decision, action or omission of the Procuring Entity is in contravention to the provisions of the Act or the Rules of the Guidelines issued there under, he may file an appeal to First Appellate Authority, as specified in the Bidding Document within a period of ten days from the date of such decision or action, omission, as the case may be, clearly giving the specific ground or ground on which he feels aggrieved:

Provided that after the declaration of a Bidder as successful the appeal may be filed only by a Bidder who has participated in procurement proceedings:

Provided further that in case a procuring entity evaluates the technical bids before the opening of the financial bids, an appeal related to the matter of financial bids may be filed only by a bidder whose technical bid is found to be acceptable.

The Officer to whom an appeal is filed under Para (1) shall deal with the appeal as expeditiously as possible and shall endeavor to dispose it of within thirty days from the date of the appeal.

- (iv) If the officer designated under Para (1) fails to dispose of the appeal filed within the period specified in Para (2), or if the bidder or prospective bidder or the procuring entity is aggrieved by the order passed by the first appellate authority, the bidder or prospective bidder or the procuring entity, as the case may be, may file a second appeal to second appellate authority specified in the bidding document in this behalf within fifteen days from the expiry of the period specified in Para (2) or of the date of receipt of the order passed by the first appellate authority, as the case may be.

(v) Appeal not to lie in certain cases

No appeal shall lie against any decision of the procuring entity relating to the following matters, namely:-

- (a) Determination of need of procurement;
- (b) Provision limiting participation of Bidders in the Bid process;

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- (c) The decision of whether or not to enter into negotiations;
- (d) Cancellation of a procurement process;
- (e) Applicability of the provisions of confidentiality.

(vi) Form of Appeal

(vii) Fee for filling appeal

- (b) The fee shall be paid in the form of bank demand draft or banker's cheque of a scheduled bank in India payable in the name of appellate authority concerned.

(viii) Procedure for disposal of appeal

- (a) The first appellate authority or second appellate authority, as the case may be, upon filling of appeal, shall issue notice accompanied by copy of appeal, affidavit and documents, if any, to the respondents and fix date of hearing.
- (b) On the date fixed for hearing, the first appellate authority or second appellate authority, as the case may be, shall,
 - (i) Hear all the parties to appeal present before him; and
 - (ii) Peruse or inspect documents, relevant records or copies thereof relating to the matter.
- (c) After hearing the parties, perusal or inspection of documents and relevant records or copies thereof relating to the matter, the appellate authority concerned shall pass an order in writing and provide the copy of order to the parties free of cost.
- (d) The order passed under sub-clause (c) above shall be placed on the State Public procurement Portal.



22. Compliance with the code of integrity and no conflict of interest:

Any person participating in a procurement process shall-

- a) Not offer any bribe, reward or gift or any material benefit either directly or indirectly in exchange for an unfair advantage in procurement process or to otherwise influence the procurement process;
- b) Not misrepresent or omit misleads or attempts to mislead so as to obtain a financial or other benefit or avoid an obligation;
- c) Not indulge in any collusion, Bid rigging or any-competitive behavior to impair the transparency, fairness and progress of the procurement process;
- d) Not misuse any information shared between the procuring Entity and the Bidders with an intent to gain unfair advantage in the procurement process;
- e) Not indulge in any coercion including impairing or harming or threatening to do the same, directly or indirectly, to any part or to its property to influence the procurement process;
